How Far Can An Electric Van Travel?

However, the advertised range is not always the same as real-world driving range.

Just like a diesel van's fuel economy can change depending on driving conditions, an electric van's range can vary depending on several factors.

These include:

- Driving speed
- Weather conditions
- Payload weight
- Road conditions
- Driving style
- Use of heating and air conditioning
- Motorway driving

A lightly loaded van travelling locally will generally achieve a different range compared with a fully loaded van travelling at motorway speeds.

Understanding Electric Van Range

When looking at an electric van, the most important question is not:

"How many miles do I actually drive every day?"

Many businesses overestimate their daily mileage.

A tradesperson might think they need maximum range, but after tracking their journeys they may discover they regularly travel much less than expected.
